VDOT Issues

Bikeway Projects Status Report

- **James City County**

A brief review was given of the improvements to Longhill Road including the improvements to the overpass over 199. There were questions regarding lane widths and how cyclists would be accommodated on the overpass. Staff provided answers regarding lane widths and on-road accommodations.

- **City of Williamsburg**

An update on expected construction for the bike path along Monticello Avenue and where/how it will tie into the cycle track through the Midtown development. There was also a discussion regarding bike share and the city's interest in a bike share program. Staff indicated that the City would be interested in working with the William & Mary on a bike share program.

Member Reed Nester discussed the improvements on Longhill Road and Monticello Avenue. He also mentioned the Smart Cycling Training held at the Municipal building.
