# DAV York County Victory Chapter 13 Served

## **FY ending 30 June 2018**

- **assisted 2,089 veterans**
- **1,818 of these for veterans' benefits information and claims and military records requests submissions**
- **233 veterans & families assisted with Emergency Relief and Homeless Relief**

*This total is an increase of 46.7 % over the FY 2016 veterans assisted for claims and benefits information assistance and an increase of 37.3 % over the previous year's total veterans assisted with claims assistance.*

## **Already this Year, as of 10 October:**

- **Assisted 879 veterans**
- **835 of these for veterans benefits and claims**
- **44 veterans & families assisted with Emergency Relief and Homeless Relief**



## **DAV 13 assists Local Veterans & Families**

### **Last FY 2017 ending 30 June 2018:**

- **Assisted 233 veterans and families granting \$20,915.59**
- **Received added funds from VFW Post 824 and other DAV Chapters bringing assistance total up to \$30,654.29**

### **This Year as of 10 October 2018:**

- **Assisted 44 veterans and families granting \$3,676.75**
- **Received added participating funds and gifts bringing assistance total up to \$4663.43**
