Anna Drake presented the application, property maps, photographs, and the plans for a two-foot channelward replacement bulkhead. VMRC determined the project is located on a manmade body of water.

The Acting Chair opened the public hearing. Dan Shipley, the property owner, and Paul Morris the agent and contractor were in attendance.

Rebecca Yasky asked whether the decks along the shoreline would be removed and Paul Morris responded that the wood decks would be removed, but the shed would be replaced.

The Chair closed the public hearing.

The Board opened deliberations. All members agreed the project was necessary.

Noel West moved to approve the application with the revised information and drawings submitted on April 18 and May 7, 2018.

Anna Drake presented the application, property maps, photographs, plans and revised drawings.

The Chair opened the public hearing. Mo Bloxum, the property owner's agent, spoke on behalf of the application. He stated the replacement bulkhead would be vinyl instead of wood because vinyl bulkheads last much longer.
