EASTBOUND TRAFFIC SHIFTS STARTING TONIGHT FOR SEGMENT II OF I-64 WIDENING PROJECT

Motorists are advised to stay alert to new traffic patterns eastbound starting the morning of March 28

YORK COUNTY— Interstate traffic shifts for the second segment of the I-64 Widening Project are scheduled to take place overnight this week, moving traffic to the right and center travel lanes on I-64.

The scheduled traffic shifts will take place overnight tonight, Wednesday, March 27, through Friday, March 29, weather permitting, on I-64 east, starting from 1.05 miles west of Route 199 (Humelsine Parkway/Marquis Center Parkway) near exit 242, and working towards the eastern project limits, approximately 0.54 miles east of Yorktown Road (exit 247). Motorists will begin using the right and center travel lanes throughout this section, beginning the morning of Thursday, March 28.

To complete the traffic shift operations, there will be single lane closures on I-64 east, as well as full ramp closures overnight starting as early as 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. as follows:

- Wednesday, March 27:
 - I-64 east off-ramps to Route 199 (exits 242A/B)
 - I-64 east on-ramp from Route 199 west
- Thursday, March 28:
 - I-64 east off-ramp to Route 60/Busch Gardens (exit 243A)
 - I-64 east on-ramp from Route 199 east
- Friday, March 29:
 - I-64 east off-ramp to Route 143 (exit 243B)
 - I-64 east on-ramp from Route 60
 - I-64 east off-ramp to Route 238/Yorktown Road (exit 247)

Signed detours will be in place. Motorists are advised to obey the reduced 55 mph speed limit and drive with caution when traveling in the construction area.

All project work and scheduled closures are dependent upon weather conditions.
