Drug Take Back Program



- We have held two events per year since 2010
- Partner with D.E.A.
- Deterra available at YPSO & YCFLS
- Avg. of 190 pounds at each of last two events

Opioid Prevention

- We are partnering with York County Youth Commission to hold a Community Forum tomorrow night (April 17, 2019)
- Since January 2017 we have had 68 documented opioid related overdoses. 12 resulted in death, 50 were saved using Narcan and the other 6 survived without the need for Narcan.
- D.A.R.E. program teaches about prescription medication abuse
- Major Montgomery sits on the Historic Triangle Drug Prevention Coalition
- We are also working on the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas (HIDTA) which is a coalition to address opioid and drug trafficking.

Opioid Arrests

- Working with the US ATTORNEY on a York County case where there has been multiple federal indictments.
- We have had a successful prosecution at the local level with multiple individuals convicted in a heroin related death.
- We have had recent arrests in York County related to heroin trafficking working with the Virginia State Police Task Force.

Community Involvement

- Sheriff's Citizens Academy once per year
- Sheriff's Youth Citizens Academy in the Fall
- Starting an Explorer Program in the Fall for ages 14 – 20. A 14 year old must be in the 9th grade.
- Fourth year partnering with NN to hold a Summer Youth Leadership Program.

Marquis S/C, 2 Juveniles escaped from NN Detention Home ran and hid in woods, Saber tracked and forced them to move and were captured


Traffic stop, alerted to drugs, found sawed-off shotgun, 2 handguns, AR-15, and body armor
