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OLDE TOWNE EXECUTIVE MEDICAL DIRECTOR TO RETIRE

Williamsburg, Va. – Dr. William J. Mann, Jr. is retiring from his position as Executive Medical Director of Olde Towne Medical & Dental Center, it was announced by Tom Brownlie, OTMDC Board Chair. Dr. Mann will retire effective August 1, 2020, a position he has held since 2013.

Dr. Mann led the effort to enhance the delivery of medical care and its timely availability. He was instrumental in the expanded use of nurse practitioners, allowing for daily walk-ins and quicker new patient scheduling. Dr. Mann established key partnerships with community resources to expand the services offered; including Virginia Board of Pharmacy and Hampton University School of Pharmacy expanding access to medications, Virginia Commonwealth University providing medical students to support the only prenatal safety net program in the community and the Williamsburg Lions Club to staff a much needed eye clinic.

During Dr. Mann's tenure, the Center has markedly enhanced the delivery of medical and dental care to James City County, York County and the City of Williamsburg residents. Under his leadership, available hours of dental care were increased, significant upgrades were made to the dental operatory, and oral health exams were incorporated into the existing prenatal and diabetic primary care regiment. In 2018, the Williamsburg Health Foundation recognized Olde Towne for its contributions in improving the community's oral health care.

Dr. Mann developed or expanded key relationship or outreach efforts with the business community, the JCC/Williamsburg and York public schools, the House of Mercy, ARC, PAA and low-cost housing projects. He also has increased the involvement of OTMDC in community health fairs and other like events in order to better reach those in the community with needed critical health care.

The Lilypad Award for outperforming peer rural primary care clinics in efficiency and operational excellent was recently awarded to Olde Towne under Dr. Mann's strong and viable financial and administrative leadership.

Olde Towne Medical & Dental Center is a public-private nonprofit medical center providing cost-effective, comprehensive primary and preventative medical (including prenatal) and dental care to the uninsured and underinsured, Medicaid and Medicare population living and working in James City County, York County and the City of Williamsburg since 1993. At the heart of the Center's mission is the provision of preventative care, early intervention services and chronic disease management to a vulnerable and disadvantaged population with services to children and their families as a priority.

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
