

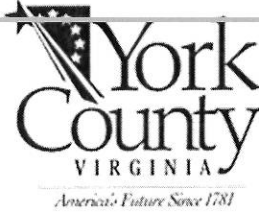

Subject: **Beginning of Construction Notice**
Carver Gardens Water Main and Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation/Replacement Project

The purpose of this letter is to announce the start of construction on the Carver Gardens Water main and Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation/Replacement Project. The general contractor for the project is Henry S. Branscome, LLC. The project time frame is 9-10 months starting early August 2017 and ending around May 2018.

As with any construction project, there will be some inconveniences. Examples are construction traffic, minor traffic delays, noise, dust, disturbed roadways and so forth which are most common. There will be full access for all emergency vehicles and typical traffic including mail delivery, trash and recycling collection, school buses, etc. Please remember that these are temporary inconveniences. Our contractor is responsible for contacting Ms. Utilities of Virginia prior to any excavation.

The County's Construction Project Manager is Richard Sutton (757-890-3771) and Jeffery Moore (757-890-3244) is the Project Inspector.
