Hampton Peninsula Community Vaccination Clinic (CVC) Now Accepting Walk-ins for Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine for Children Ages 5-11

Newport News, Va. — On Friday, November 12, 2021, the Hampton Peninsula Community Vaccination Clinic (CVC) will accept walk-ins for the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine for children ages 5 to 1. For those who prefer appointments for 5-11 year olds, or anyone eligible, go on line to vaccinate.virginia.gov or call 877-VAX-IN-VA (877-829-4682).

The Hampton Peninsula CVC is located at 13785 Warwick Boulevard, Newport News, VA in the Sherwood Shopping Center-formerly the Ferguson Building. The CVC operates Monday through Saturday from 10 a.m. until 8 p.m. with the last appointment at 7:30 pm.

First (1st), second (2nd) and boosters are also available to individuals who received the second dose of Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 or Moderna vaccine or a first dose of Johnson & Johnson vaccine six or more months ago and meet one of the following criteria:

- Are 65 years and older
- 18 and above with underlying medical conditions
- Live or work in a high risk setting (ex: healthcare workers, first responders, teachers, educational staff, grocery store employees, postal employees, and others)

Everyone 5 years and older is eligible to be vaccinated against COVID-19. Hampton & Peninsula Health Districts encourage all Virginians to get their vaccination if they have not already done so. Vaccination is the surest path back to normal. **All vaccinations are free and available to anyone living in the United States.**
