

# Military Personnel as a Share of Hampton Roads Employment






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

# Median Household Income





# Real Estate Tax Rate Comparison


Real Estate Tax Rates (Per \$100 of Assessed Value) As of July 2016



# 2015 Peninsula Crime Rates Per 100,000 Population


