SUBJECT: Waterfront Projects 

From time to time County staff works in tandem with County civic organizations on community improvement projects. The projects discussed here reflect two that are currently underway.

The Yorktown Rotary Club and the Department of Public Works are coordinating the installation of a 20-foot x 28-foot Enwood picnic pavilion on the grounds of the National Park Service waterfront picnic area. The National Park Service approved the structure, and the Yorktown Rotary Club donated the money for the cost of the shelter and will provide the labor for its construction. The Department of Public Works will support the Yorktown Rotary Club's construction efforts and finish the project to include ADA compliant picnic tables and aggregate concrete. The project is expected to be completed early in December. The pavilion will be similar to those installed in other County facilities such as New Quarter Park, the MAC, and Charles Brown Park.



The Grafton Kiwanis Club donated a Dero Fixit bicycle service station. The station includes tools necessary to perform basic bike repairs which are attached to the stand with cables and tamper-proof fasteners. The service station was installed by the Public Works' Facility Maintenance Division, and the Kiwanis Club has agreed to maintain the fixture. Since the TransAmerica Bicycle Trail terminates in Yorktown, the addition of this fixture is especially significant.



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
