York County Fire and Life Safety Responds to Commercial Structure Fire at Rocco's Smokehouse Grill in Northern York

At approximately 7:15 a.m. this morning, personnel from the York County Department of Fire and Life Safety were dispatched to the report of a commercial structure fire at Rocco's Smokehouse Grill in the 200 block of Bypass Road. Upon arrival, fire and rescue units observed smoke coming from the back of the restaurant.

The fire was reported by an employee of the restaurant who had safely exited the building. There were no other employees present, and no injuries occurred. The restaurant was not yet open to the public.

The fire was quickly located inside the structure and extinguished. Mutual aid assistance was provided by the City of Williamsburg Fire Department.

The cause of the fire is under investigation.
