



Storm-related Yard Debris Collection; Residents must call to arrange pickup

October 10, 2016

York County will collect storm-related yard debris at no charge from Monday, October 10, through Friday, October 21. County residents must call to arrange for the debris pickup by calling the Waste Management Office at (757) 890-3780 or by placing an online customer service request using the link found on the county's home page: www.yorkcounty.gov.

PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT:

- Debris is placed within 10 feet of the road.
- Debris does not block the road.
- Debris is not near trees, poles, or other structures; under power lines; or over utility manholes. All of these make removal difficult.
- Debris set out for curbside collections should be no larger than 10 feet in length and 8 inches in diameter. Debris must be all natural vegetative debris - no dirt or root balls, boards, or other type of construction debris.
- Leaves and grass clippings can be set out for pickup, but **MUST** be in clear bags.

Debris can be delivered to the VPPSA Composting Facility located at 145 Goodwin Neck Road (county Waste Management Center). Materials delivered to VPPSA can be no larger than 10 feet in length and 24 inches in diameter. VPPSA hours are Monday through Saturday, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.
