



## November Fun at Your Library

The York County Public Library offers a wide variety of programs, activities and fun for all ages during November. All programs are free and open to the public.

The Library is sponsoring a Food for Fines amnesty program November 1-15 to benefit local food closets. If you have overdue materials on your account, you may bring nonperishable food items to the Tabb or Yorktown Library to pay your fines. One food item will pay one fine, regardless of the amount of the fine. You may bring as many food items as you have overdue books, DVDs or CDs. The Food for Fines program does not apply to charges for lost or damaged items. Bring your canned or boxed food items to the Circulation desk, along with your library card, to receive credit on your account. Previously opened and expired food items will not be accepted.

The Friends of the Library are having the Fall Book Sale on November 4-6, at the Yorktown Library. On Friday, November 4, the sale is open from noon to 6 p.m. to members of the York County Friends of the Library. New members are welcome to join at the door. The sale opens to the general public on Saturday, November 5 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. and from 1-5 p.m. on Sunday, November 6.

Explore America's musical heritage with the Upriver band on Monday, November 7, at the Yorktown Library. *Discovering Folk Instruments* is a special performance at 4:30 p.m. just for kids. This interactive program will include performances of children's folk songs and Celtic music, as well as give children the chance to play a guitar, banjo, dulcimer or fiddle. At 7 p.m., all ages are welcome to enjoy Upriver's performance, *To Appalachia and Beyond*, with songs from the Appalachian, Gospel, Bluegrass and Contemporary Folk music traditions.

The Library Board of Trustees will meet at 5 p.m. on Thursday, November 10, in the Yorktown Library meeting room. The public is invited to attend.

A new session of story times begins Tuesday, November 1, at the Tabb and Yorktown Libraries. Programs are available for newborns through 5-year-olds.
